Downtown Books is happy to host groups either during store hours or after hours.

We can open the doors for your group at 8:00 a.m. on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, or Friday. (Wednesdays are reserved for the Downtown Business Association meeting.) In addition, we are happy to stay open if you choose to begin your meeting at 5:00 p.m., or come back to open the doors for a later meeting time. The store would be available from 5:00-9:00 p.m..

We will need a two-day advance notice. Reservations are on a first-come, first-serve basis. Reservations may be made in person, by phone (824-5343) or by email (downtown@cvjbooks.com). Fees are payable in cash, by check, or credit card and must be paid within 24 hours of the meeting time.
